

Graduation Requirements/Dual Credit

- Proposed changes align PHS graduation requirements to state requirements allowing more flexibility for students to follow individual educational pathways.
 - English I
 - English II
 - Two additional English credits
 - Algebra I
 - Geometry
 - Two additional math credits aligned to the student's ILP
 - Two science credits that shall incorporate lab based scientific investigation experiences
 - One additional science credit
 - Two social studies credits to include the content contained in the Kentucky Academic Standards
 - One additional social studies credit
- Students receive one full credit per class at the end of each school year.
- Dual Credit partnerships are active with BSCTCS, Morehead State University, The University of Pikeville, and the University of Kentucky.
 - To take dual credit courses the student must meet the requirements set by the cooperating institutions.
 - When a dual credit course is offered with an "in person" teacher at PHS or designated location that will be the preferred method for taking the course.
 - If a student fails a dual credit course, the student will not be permitted to take dual credit classes the following semester.
 - Students must take English IV or college level English through PHS.
