
Using these insights, we prioritize Mercer County's values and goals, translating them into tailored, innovative solutions that guide the design and planning of your new football stadium and tennis courts, including:

- Functionality and Flexibility: Determine the range of sports the complex will support and ensure the design can adapt to multiple sports. Include practice and competition fields with optimal layouts. Plan for the complex to support non-sporting events like concerts, community gatherings, and school events, adding flexibility.
- Safety and Accessibility: Include secure entry and exit points for athletes, spectators, and emergency personnel, along with pathways that prevent crowd congestion. Ensure the facility is fully accessible.
- Player and Spectator Safety: Designate areas that protect players and spectators from hazards like errant balls or overcrowding.
- Operational Costs: Incorporate sustainable features such as water-saving fixtures and LED lighting..
 Consider synthetic turf options that reduce water and maintenance needs or natural turf for an environmentally friendly, low-cost option.
- 5. Spectator Experience: Design comfortable seating with clear sightlines to the field for all spectators. Include designated areas for students, families, and visiting team fans. Provide well-placed amenities like restrooms, concession stands, and locker rooms that are easily accessible and well-equipped.
 - Equip fields with modern scoreboards and PA systems to enhance the game-day experience.
- 6. Future Expansion: Plan the complex to accommodate future expansions or upgrades, allowing for growth in school enrollment or new sports programs.
- Budget Management To ensure accuracy and avoid surprises, we integrate construction cost considerations throughout the planning process.

Likewise, we will take what we heard and prioritize Mercer County's goals and values, while considering the following in the planning and design of the athletic facilities:

- Field Houses Locker Rooms and Training Spaces:
 Plan locker rooms with showers and training rooms for
 injury management. Ensure they're close to the fields
 for quick access and safety.
- Storage Provide ample storage for equipment, maintenance tools, and game-day supplies.
- Parking and Transportation Ensure there's enough parking and consider bus access points for visiting teams, drop-off zones, and easy access for fans with disabilities.
- 4. Concessions Place the concession stand near the main entrance, bleachers, or other gathering spots to maximize visibility and convenience. Include multiple service windows to handle peak times, allowing for separate lines for food, drinks, and other services.
- 5. Comfort and Aesthetics Design awnings, canopies, or overhangs to shield the stand and patrons from the elements, such as sun or rain. Use the school's colors, logo, and team emblems in the design to create a sense of pride and school spirit around the concession stand. If space permits, include a seating area nearby for patrons to comfortably enjoy their food.
- Energy Saving Designs Incorporate energy-efficient appliances and lighting to reduce operational costs and environmental impact. Include recycling and trash disposal options that are easy to access and manage during busy games and events.

With over 300 ft of grade change on the site, designers created terraces to centrally locate the school and various athletic fields. The new Boyd County High School, completed in 2013, set the foundation for an enhanced athletic environment. Positioned with two prominent public facades, one facing the future athletic fields and the other serving as the school's main entry, the building integrates seamlessly with the community's vision for accessible, high-quality sports facilities.

Following the high school's completion, the new athletic complex was unveiled in two phases, becoming a visible landmark from the entry road and symbolizing community pride and engagement in school athletics. This phased master plan brought to life facilities that cater to a wide range of athletic and extracurricular activities, making Boyd County High School a central hub for sports, physical education, and community events.

Football & Soccer Complex

The new football and soccer complex offers a modern venue for a variety of sports and activities. The complex is used for football soccer, band practice, band competitions, and physical education classes. The football & soccer complex includes:

Softball Complex

The natural grass sports turf in the outfield transitions to a natural warning track along the fence for player safety. The infield includes a natural clay surface and the home plate is enclosed with a backstop wall and net system. Both home and visiting teams have their own bullpens and set of bleachers. An underground drainage system ensures water is properly drained from the field.

The bleachers surround a masonry building directly behind home plate with a press box on the second floor and concessions and restrooms on the first floor. The press box facility echoes the architecture of the nearby high school. The complex is connected to the high school by a pedestrian sidewalk for student and staff accessibility.





Strategically located adjacent to the football, soccer, and track facility, the building serves as a gateway to the athletic complex, offering concessions and public restrooms to enhance the experience for visitors and spectators.

Inside, the building houses essential spaces for both athletic programs and officials, including a fully equipped weight room, officials' locker room, offices, uniform storage, a laundry room, equipment storage, and dedicated office space. Additionally, the facility includes a physical education classroom and two standard classrooms, providing

versatile space for both athletics and academics.


The project also involved significant upgrades to the athletic fields, including the replacement of the existing track, installation of new sports lighting, updated bleachers, site grading, and expanded parking to improve accessibility. The facility is divided by a large covered breezeway that includes ticketing and seatwalls with integrated landscaping as a welcoming entrance to the complex.


The baseball complex features a synthetic turf infield with natural grass outfield with irrigation system. The softball complex features a natural clay surface infield and natural grass outfield. Both complexes include dug outs, lighting, home and visitor bleachers for 760 patrons, as well as a masonry, load bearing two-story pressbox with first floor storage and views of the entire field.

The four competition tennis courts are adjacent to both the softball and baseball fields, all of which are accessible from a large, central public courtyard space designed to handle a large number of visitors for the multiple sports venues.

After interactive design charrettes with the administration, teachers and district staff, Sherman Carter Barnhart created a phased implementation plan based on the priority of needs and funds available.

Phase I focused on the need for a performing arts department including a state-of-the-art auditorium and improvements to the athletic support spaces. Adjacent to the new theater and connected to the existing gym, a new athletics addition was designed within the old stage and basement locker rooms. The athletics space features a weight room, storage and locker rooms.

Phase II of the Meade County High School Expansion & Renovation consisted of a new 8,000 SF cafeteria, a new wrestling room located beneath the cafeteria, new energy efficient HVAC systems, as well as electrical systems upgrades and interior finishes.

Phase III focused on improvements at the football/soccer stadium. Improvements included:
