1. Opening Business - Mrs. Hayes called the meeting to order at 3:02 pm.
  - a. Attendance - Laura Beth Hayes, Lyndsay Booth (via google meet), Keshia Goodman, Hope Anderson, and Corrina Holmes were in attendance. Julie Nevitt was absent. Ivy Taylor was a guest.
  - b. Agenda Approval
    - i. Ms. Goodman made a motion to accept the agenda as written.
    - ii. Ms. Holmes seconded the motion. **Consensus**
  - c. November Meeting Minutes Approval
    - i. Ms. Booth made a motion to approve the minutes by amending the attendance section with *Keshia Goodman was absent.*
    - ii. Ms. Goodman seconded the motion. **Consensus**
  - d. Good News Report
    - i. ISD walkthroughs were positive
    - ii. iReady data is right on target with last year's data, slightly higher than last year. Sixty three percent of students have hit desired growth.
    - iii. Successful NTI experience last week. Expected glitches with technology and early childhood, but received praise from CO on the way NPES handled it. Compliments from parents on the smoothness and the clarity in communication. Revealed holes in communication with ELL families and provided opportunities to serve them better.
    - iv. Kudos to Ivy Taylor, Family Resource Coordinator, who went above and beyond to provide food and winter clothing to families during NTI and winter storms. She also made deliveries to those with no transportation. We also commend her involvement with the recent Winter Coat drive.
    - v. Lots of great things happened in December - family involvement activities and fun activities in the classroom.
    - vi. Mrs. Hayes received permission to create a district wide NTI for elementary - to allow for consistency within the district

PLUS consideration for families and their access to materials needed for a successful NTI day.

- vii. Connections Breakfast focusing on academics is happening tomorrow - more than 40 families have RSVPd. Intention is to equip families with tools for behavior, parenting, academics, and to connect with families. Feeder school FRCs will be present. A Connection Breakfast focusing on behavior is planned for the following Friday.
- viii. Ms. Taylor discussed a connection via an extended family member to a book distribution company. Three thousand five hundred books will be able to be distributed throughout the district including both children and adult books. Shipping has been covered by donations. Once storage is secured, the books will be delivered.
- ix. Derby at NHHS track will be held on April 30th. North Middle will also be involved.
- x. K graduation at NHHS will be held on May 20th and be divided into two sessions. This will allow for more tickets to be given to each family so other family members may attend.
- xi. Cradle School has moved back to North Park allowing for more collaboration and connections with future families.
