## **Currently Working On:**

• <u>KY ILN Travel Grant</u>; \$3,000 for travel to model schools and/or exemplary conferences that promote and concern learner-centered and innovative practices programmatically.

## **Submitted Grants:**

- <u>United Way of Southern Kentucky Application</u>; requesting funding for Jump Start Kindergarten, FRYSC support, and for high school college/career readiness. This will be for 2026.
- <u>KY Numeracy Counts K-3 HQIR Grant</u>; \$70,000 for K-3<sup>rd</sup> grade high quality curriculum aligned to K-3 academic standards in mathematics & curriculum-based professional learning to implement the new curriculum.
- <u>KY State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program</u>; reimbursement grant of up to \$10,000 with a required 20-30% match. Asking for funds for new server and cloud back-up solution. *Grant submitted by Kristin Smith*.

## **Recently Awarded Grants:**

- KDE Comprehensive Literacy Grant; awarded \$1.3 million over 5 years to provide Tier 1 reading high-quality instructional resources for preschool through 12<sup>th</sup> grades, and to improve reading instruction by providing professional learning for instructional staff. Given current federal government review of programs, we are currently guaranteed year one funding (\$260,000) with the continuation of funds for this award dependent on continued federal budget allocation.
- We Lead Computer Science Chamber Grant; \$20,000 to the Scottsville-Allen County Chamber of Commerce to connect local/regional employers with ACSHS students to build a talent and recruitment pipeline for students in various needed technology fields. Grant will be used by the Chamber to conduct community engagement for Chamber members, local/regional businesses/industries to promote building the technology career pipeline and recruitment effort at ACS. It also provides outreach to parents and students to promote the requirements and benefits of pursuing computer science career pathways. Mentorships, internships, and work-based learning activities for ACS students will also be developed.
