Trades Observed on Site: Carpenters, Excavators

1. Work observed in Progress

- The site had recovered well from the recent flooding rains to the point that excavations and earth moving were proceeding normally.
- Excavating and earth moving was ongoing. b)
- Preparing areas for the next footing pour. c)
- d) Preparing steel reinforcing for footings.

2. General Observations

The building pad had dried due to a) sunny/breezy conditions after the flooding rains that occurred the week before.



b) Some mud was washed onto the footings from the rains. The mud will need to be removed before the stem walls are added.



The footing on the southeast corner drops c) significantly to bear on suitable soils. The reinforcement that was in place reflects that. The footing bottoms appeared to be firm.



d) Steel reinforcement was in place at the northeast corner.



e) The footing steps to the southeast. Steel reinforcing was placed on concrete block risers.



f) Soils were being removed to reach plan bottoms.



g) Once soils were excavated, it was removed to the area in front of the facilities building for loading onto dump trucks.



h) The excess soils were being loading into dump trucks for disposal off site.



3. Stored Material Observed:

- a) Concrete accessories.
- b) Geothermal piping.

4. Follow up items:

a) Note any changes to the plans on the As-Built Drawings.
