Meeting called to order at 3:48 PM by Chairperson Meyers

- 1. Opening Business
  - a. Approval of the Agenda
    - i. Motion to approve the agenda made by Mr. Fitzgerald, second by Ms. Kohrs. No objections.
  - b. Approval of the February Minutes
    - i. Motion to approve the February minutes made by Mrs. Kohrs, second by Mr. Fitzgerald. No objections.
  - b. Good News Report
    - i. Mr. Ratterman brought up the videos that were created via our Energy Bus activity last week. The videos were excellent and offered a great demonstration of the value of the Energy Bus Program.
    - ii. Mrs. Kohrs shared that she has four seniors who are participating in a career fair-type professional development. Students will get direct instruction about professional skills and then students will also create a "brag" board to present at a career fair where potential employers are looking to fill vacancies.
    - iii. Mr. Meyers shared the success of the robotics competition hosted by DHS. As well as how fantastic our robotics club represented Dayton High School.
    - iv. Mr. Meyers discussed how well Parent Engagement Day #3 went. We had nearly 70% contact with all families in the building through in-person meetings, emails, and phone calls. There were quite a few parents and families who expressed how happy their children were to attend DHS.
  - c. Public Comment

- 2. Student Achievement Report/Data
  - a. Post-Secondary Rate
    - i. 84% (59/70) of senior class is Post-Secondary Ready
    - ii. 51% (24/47) of junior class is Post-Secondary Ready

- iii. 19% (12/63) of sophomore class is Post-Secondary Ready
- b. Honor Roll/Super Honor Roll 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter
  - i. Mr. Meyers shared the Honor Roll and Super Honor Roll numbers for the third quarter. Numbers were down compared to the first quarter honor roll/super honor roll lists, but significantly higher rate than the second quarter honor roll/super honor roll lists.
- c. Graduation Rate Update Class of 2025
  - i. Mr. Meyer reiterated there are a handful of students who are struggling to get across the finish line to graduation. Those students have been identified and are receiving extra services.

## 3. Budget Report

- a. Mr. Meyers made a request for funds from the FRYSC to help offset the costs for caps and gowns. Council Members approved the request.
- b. Council members had no other questions about this month's budget report.

## 4. Committee Reports – Special Education

- a. Ms. Kohrs shared some highlights of the Special Education Report:
  - i. She shared failures by grade level as well as the services that have been offered to those students.
  - ii. The average course failure rate for 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> quarters is 18.7%. The third quarter specifically had a failure rate of 25.4% for 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter-which was historically the highest course failure quarter during the school year.
  - iii. Multiple students on Special Education caseloads are on Super Honor Roll and A/B Honor Roll.
