CEP Reminders and Key Points.

Identified Student Percentage (ISP)

The ISP is the percentage of students participating in SNAP, Medicaid, or TANF, or identified as Homeless or Foster Care.

Qualifying parameters for these programs have recently changed. However, ISPs have remained relatively stable for the District.

ISP Groupings and CEP Funding

Schools can be grouped together to maximize CEP reimbursement, based on ISP percentage.

The ISP groupings of schools are reviewed annually. Alterations can be made to ensure the most lucrative reimbursement amount.

Average Daily Participation in New CEP Schools Has Increased

Breakfast and lunch participation data shows an increase at new CEP schools this year.
