A sewage ejector pump is recommended at the physical science center annex building to pump sanitary waste from the new facility to an existing sanitary manhole that is at a higher elevation than the building's finished floor. This recommendation is the result of revising the site sanitary routing to avoid conflict with existing site utilities (the geothermal well field) and primary electrical lines already installed. The pump inside the building will mitigate the need for a separate site lift station that would have required additional equipment and site power.
