
Comparison Year: 12-mo ending Feb 2008 (TFMS = 12-mo ending Feb 2012)



Key takeaways this month:

- 1. February 2025 was significantly colder than February 2024 resulting in a 28% increase in Heating Degree Days (HDD). As a result, district energy usage increased 17%.
- 2. Three schools saw an increase in ENERGY STAR scores in February.
- 3. Beechgrove Elementary had the largest decrease in electrical usage over spring break reducing their electrical consumption by 36%.






Moving from Monthly Billing Data to 15-minute Interval Data
