Phase IV CDIP NTI plans, and the Professional Development Plan for 25-26 have been completed. CSIP professional development plans have also been completed. THe Lau Plan for english language learners is the last piece for completion.

Juniors took the ACT on Tuesday, 3/11/25. Students gave a good effort. Our composite score was 20.1. Slightly lower than last year, but we are still pleased with the results, which include a 34, a 32 and several above 21.

CTE students have completed their EOP assessments. We feel as though we got really good effort from our students. We scored above the state mean in Administrative Support, Consumer and Family Services aswell as Early Childhood Education. Information and Support services was just below the mean.

Elementary staff has been in the process of reviewing the math curriculum. Bridges will be the HQIR of choice. We are in discussions as to which edition we should purchase, as the most recent edition has not been fully adopted as an HQIR – but it is anticipated to do be adopted.

We have begun to schedule students with We Lead. Currently we have two students that we are working with. Although not a big number, for inauguration it is not unexpected, and is expected to grow.

Weekly instructional meetings continue to occur in both buildings, seeking to identify plus-deltas that can be used to promote growth in each building.

We have submitted test dates for KSA testing. The window will be May 6th until the end of school.
