HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

At the beginning of the school year, Zoeyanna Compton, Bahadir Gunbeyi, and Aaliyah Dishman, Dixie Heights High School students in the class of 2026, each submitted a Letter of Intent to Apply for Early Graduation for Spring 2025. The students completed an entrance interview with the principal to discuss postsecondary goals and career aspirations. In addition, the students completed all the Early Graduation Program requirements and successfully presented a Capstone Project by earning "Mastery" and/or "Partial Mastery" on all four components of the rubric. All three students successfully completed all Early Graduation Program requirements to include being KCSD Transition Ready and are eligible to receive a diploma and an Early Graduation certificate.
