To All,

I am attaching two Excel Spreadsheets to this email, one showing how much money is in the supplement pools at some of the schools that are in our district, that we may have on the schedule, are near us or are of similar size to us. The second attachment shows some figures for equipment needs in terms of reconditioning, replacement, or addition.

As far as the supplement pool I would like to increase the total value of the pool to \$17,000 which would allow us to add a minimum of two coaching supplements while restructuring the three already in place. This would allow us to have two coaches that would be primarily JV coaches while still assisting at the Varsity level. A total pool value of \$17,000 would put us at a much more comparable amount to the schools in our district as well as schools who are demographically similar to us, such as Trigg County (\$18,300).

The equipment fund would pay to do several things that would help bring our equipment up to par and playable for the numbers we currently have in place. I am expecting our numbers to grow substantially this next season as we currently have about 50 players in our off season workout program not counting the 23 eighth graders that will also be joining our program. If we retain all of these student athletes will need to increase our equipment amounts drastically in some areas. We currently have 56 helmets which is approximately 15-20 short to equip all of these kids.
