KHSAA360 UPDATE (AT NO CHARGE TO SCHOOLS)

- Review of many other options over the last five years had revealed a complete transition among member state associations (primarily due to x factor)

 Excellent systems out there now that integrate with Arbiter data (which is key on assigning)

 Non are low or no cost

- Non are low or no cost

 2024-2025 (Bigger than Baby Steps, but not where we want to end up)
 Current resources, 7 developers, significant budget commitment
 Large financial commitment from Arbiter and from KHSAA

 Accomplishments
 Seamless integration with various aspects related to data, especially within Arbiter platforms such as officials, which our schools have used for decades
 Seamless integrations with GoFan digital ticketing, the NFHS Network, and the NFHSLearn platform

 KHSAA to serve as primary point of contact for member schools, especially critical with near constant turnover of ADs and rapid reassignment of duties with many third party contractors

- Accomplishments (Continued)
 Personnel Data Conversion
 Roles and Permissions Continuing to evolve
 - Student Data Conversion (rosters and intentional limitations)

 - Movement of old data to new system
 Training, Training, Training and more Training, with "some" demo at regional meetings, but lots of opportunities for one-on-one with RC
 - More in-person planned for August, 2025 in conjunction with specific region meetings
 FOCUS FOR 2024-2025 HAS BEEN ON SCHOOLS

- Timeline and Horizon and Next Steps
- Additional Positions/Role
 - Designated Representative (deadline May 3)
 - Will integrate with contracts and transfers
- End of Year Participation Reporting
 - Title IX Reporting (both initial and final)
 - Deadline Extended to May 19

KHSAA360 UPDATE (AT NO CHARGE TO SCHOOLS)

- Transfer Processing
 On schedule for roll-out for July, 2025
 Totally online and between schools
 Definitely should speed up processing but be mindful of minimum processing period (three working days)
 Onus definitely shifting to sending school to contest the facts around transfer and not association
 No charge for schools to use membership life through Arbiter forms
 Membership Form and Description
- Membership Form and Dues via Arbiter, August, 202

KHSAA360 UPDATE (AT NO CHARGE TO SCHOOLS)

- Shortcomings and Challenges
 - Focus on Association Tools
 - Continued Evolution of Tools used by Schools (even though working now transparent to users)
 - Academic All State and Triple Threat
 - Scoreboard

KHSAA360 UPDATE (AT NO CHARGE TO SCHOOLS)

- Shortcomings and Issues-Scores and Schedule Entry
- Primary issues continue to show up, and most is simply due to the fact that there are multiple cooks in the same kitchen
 - Do not re-use game slots of cancelled games
 - Do not delete games (issues with assigners), use cancel
 - Communicate with assigner if you change levels of previously entered games
- Likely some new opportunities around regular season bracketing due to Rschool acquisitiong

UPDATES - LEGISLATIVE AND LEGAL

- Revisions to Bylaw 10 around NIL and KHSAA Help for Schools with NIL education
- Continued fallout from 2022 HB563 (2023 SB145) regarding reciprocal agreements
 Bottom line, until a student is subject to the KHSAA transfer rule, the out of district ineligibility rule for athletics does not apply
- The out of distinct ineignolinity role for dimerics does not apply

 There is no new "COVID" year available for those who did not, in writing, ask for and get approved for the option by the deadline, and then spend 21-22 as a supplemental year for 2020-21.

 SB128 (2021) was extremely specific and binding on KHSAA (including financial SEEK ramifications)

UPDATES - LEGISLATIVE AND LEGAL

- Issues around Legislature are primarily in two areas. First is transfer rule
 - Current transfer rule viewed as punitive in many cases
 - Issues and changes around the nation
- Inconsistent definitions of "one-time" transfer throughout country so be careful what conclusions you draw
- Does not appear to be support in any circles for a wideopen, one-time free provision after you have played varsity (i.e. Indiana, Florida)

UPDATES - LEGISLATIVE AND LEGAL

- Legislative Issues Around Transfer Rule (continued)
- As required by statute and regulation, Board continues to look with staff at the current rule
- No one likes the current collegiate anarchy and legislative leadership, at least in one chamber, is supportive of revisions, but KHSAA member control of those revisions

 One-time free without restrictions would without a doubt favor more resource-intensive schools and lead to a widening of the success gap
- While individual members of the legislature have opinions, there is no united effort (yet)
- Keep in mind we are surrounded TN, IN, OH, WV. IL likely next.

UPDATES – LEGISLATIVE AND LEGAL

- Transfer Rule (continued)
- Issues around membership commitment to application of the rule
 - How can we get the members as excited about enforcing the rule on an enrolling student as they are on students that are leaving.

 What changes can be made to ensure integrity of the data reported (i.e. participation threshold).

 Willingness of local level to investigate given inherent restrictions.

UPDATES - LEGISLATIVE AND LEGAL

- Transfer Rule (continued)
 - When should the transfer restrictions begin, especially in light of HB563 and continued Open Borders enrollment provisions
 - Penalties for ineligibility
 - Challenges of mid-season and after contests/practice start transfers
 - Closing loopholes and remembering the displaced student

UPDATES - LEGISLATIVE AND LEGAL

- Transfer Rule (continued)
- Will compile data for board to be presented at regional and annual meetings
- Will be soliciting past two years of page one of the form via survey
- Plans at this time are to have proposals ready and final in July for discussion at Annual Meeting and a vote of the membership

UPDATES – LEGISLATIVE AND LEGAL

- Issues around Legislature are primarily in two areas. Second is non-full time enrolled student participation (bylaw 4)
 Between legislative sessions, research group will be reviewing SEEK funding
 Consideration of attendance threshold is always on the docket (ADM vs ADA)
 Funding for partly enrolled students (fractional SEEK) will again be discussed
 At least as of now, no major overhaul proposed
 Discussion of non-full time enrolled students (or a different definition for enrolled) could impact Bylaw 4 and COULD include home school provisions

- Review of Due Process Procedure
- Review of new online system may help with changes
- Timelines are a source of concern for legislature, etc even though they imposed them through KRS 13B
