Grant Funding Updates

-  **Kentucky Numeracy Counts Grant Awarded (\$70,000)**
 - KDE grant supporting K–3 math instruction improvement.
 - Funds high-quality, research-based math curriculum.
 - Supports curriculum-based professional learning for teachers.
 - **This grant will fund K–3 math curriculum and PD for Menifee Central (Eureka Squared)**
-  **AED Grant Awarded**
 - **AED = Automated External Defibrillator**
 - District will purchase 8 additional AEDs for school campuses.

Assessment Update

-  **Kentucky Summative Assessments**
 - State assessments for Grades 3–11 will conclude **next week**.

 - Currently have 17 prospective full-time children and 14 part-time.

Age of Children	Ratio	Maximum Group Size*
Infant	1 staff for 5 children	10
Toddler 12 to 24 months	1 staff for 6 children	12
Toddler 24 to 36 months	1 staff for 10 children	20
Preschool-age 3 to 4 years	1 staff for 12 children	24
Preschool-age 4 to 5 years	1 staff for 14 children	28



KIP Survey

The KIP Survey is given every two years to 6th, 8th, 10th and 12th graders. A consent form signed by parents is required for a student to take the survey.

Menifee County **6th** (44) **8th** (37) **10th** (8) **12th** (2) = 91 total students

Key Points

- Mental Health & Suicide - 13% of students have considered suicide, while 9% have attempted suicide at least once
- Alcohol - 92% of students have never used alcohol
- Tobacco - 88% of students have never used tobacco products
- Marijuana - 94% of students have never used marijuana
- Prescription & OTC Drugs - 99% of students have never used drugs without a prescription
- School Safety - 89% of students feel safe at school / 88% of students confirm that the school has a way to report bullying or harassment



KIP Survey

Menifee Co. School Responses:

- **Mental Health & Suicide**
 - All students 6th - 12th grade received suicide prevention training once in the fall and spring semester
 - Rae of Sunshine Presentation on May 6th for all 6th - 12th students
 - District and School Administrators attending KEDC Summer Institute addressing mental health on May 29, 2025
 - Character Strong purchased for all K-12th for social emotional, age-appropriate lessons
 - Partnership with Pathways (counselors in Menifee Central and MCHS)
 - KEDC Mental Health Grant participation throughout the year
- **Tobacco/Alcohol/Drugs**
 - Too Good for Drugs Classes
 - Juniper Health Vaping Classes
- **School Safety**
 - Police Department within the district
 - STOP Tipline
 - Relationship Building



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
