RETIRED TEACHERS

Retired teahcers, with at least 15 years of classroom teaching experiences, will receive an additional \$35 per day.

LONG TERM RATE FOR CERTIFIED SUBSTITUTES

A certified substitute who accepts an assignment will be paid on the regular Teacher's Salary Schedule, beginning on day 11 of that assignment. There will not be retroactive pay. To be eligible for the additional pay, the assignment must be more than 10 consecutive days in the same position and same school year. The substitute must hold a valid Kentucky Provisional or Standard Certificate, that is appropriate for the position in order to be eligible for the long term-assignment.

Retired teachers serving as substitute teachers will be paid based upon their Daily Wage Threshold (DWT) rate per the Kentucky Teachers' Retirement System, beginning on day 11 of that assignment. The rate is determined by KTRS and provided to the teacher, who is required to submit this information to Allen County Schools Human Resources Department. Retired teachers are limited to work the number of days listed on their DWT statement as determined by the Kentucky Teachers' Retirement System. It is the responsibility of each teacher to track their number of days worked within the school year.

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
