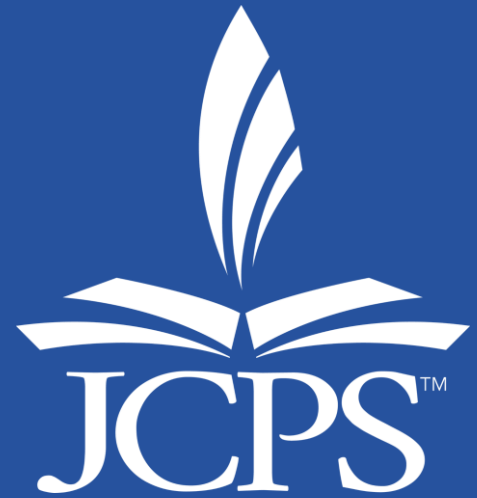


# CELL PHONE POLICY SURVEY RESULTS

# Survey Questions

**Option 1:** I support a district policy that would NOT allow phones during instructional time but are allowed at lunch and during transitions (hallways).

**Option 2:** I support a district policy that would NOT allow phones during instructional time but are allowed at lunch.

**Option 3:** I support a district policy that would ban cell phone use at school all day, including during lunch and transitions (hallways).

# Survey Results

## Middle & High School Principals

School Level	Number of Responses (100%)	Option 1 Banned During Instructional Time (allowed during lunch and transitions)	Option 2 Banned During Instructional Time and Transitions (allowed during lunch)	Option 3 Banned During the Entire School Day
High School (Grades 9–12)	22	32%	13%	55%
Middle School (Grades 6–8)	24	4%	21%	75%
MS/HS (Grades 6–12)	8	50%	25%	25%
All Schools	54	22%	19%	59%

School Level	Number of Responses (100%)	Option 1 Banned During Instructional Time (allowed during lunch and transitions)	Option 2 Banned During Instructional Time and Transitions (allowed during lunch)	Option 3 Banned During the Entire School Day
Staff	1,079	15%	25%	60%
Parents	5,389	50%	20%	30%
Students	411	81%	11%	8%
