This Change Order includes the following Change Order Requisitions:

- COR #33 Additional Asphalt Binder This 1 1/2" of thickness was added to protect the parking lot base and sub-surface geothermal wellfield while the separate Baseball/Softball construction work continued. The added asphalt section will help to preserve work installed and protect the well field into the future.
- COR #34 Core Drill Structure for 12" Drain Pipe Coring labor was required at the existing storm structure to receive an existing 12" RFP pipe that served the tennis court area. The pipe rain short of the structure when the entrance was modified.
- COR #36 Site Electrical Revisions (RFP 10) Costs associated with primary electrical lines that need to be revised along KY Highway 44 based on Salt River Utility Requirements. What was assumed in the Bid was a shorter primary electric line since it was assumed the Utility would cross the road, however, Salt River could not provide an additional road crossing since the BEHS site is already served electrically. This resulted in the electrical contractor having to provide a longer primary electrical route.



#### Good Morning Troy, Danny and Tony,

I have discussed this suggestion with Robin Mills at Buzick to add an additional 1.5" of asphalt base material to the new Parking Lot at Bullitt East that sits above the new Geothermal Field. Buzick has confirmed the quantities are in line with the work outlined here. Both SKA and Buzick agree the added 1 ½" of asphalt material would benefit the project while Construction is ongoing at that campus, both in terms of protection of the geothermal field AND longevity of the parking lot in the future.

May the Design Team authorize EH/Trademark to prepare for additional base asphalt material at the parking lot at Bullitt East? Added cost of this is approximately \$45,000 based on EH's email, below.

The anticipated paving schedule is mid-week weather dependent.

I spoke with Phillip this morning and he is anticipating a cost of approximately \$45,000 to add the additional base to the parking lot to support heavy vehicular traffic for staging. This is just a tough time of year for paving and subgrade. If the lot is going to be utilized for laydown, I would HIGHLY recommend this option. We just need to know if this is going to be pursued as soon as possible so we can adjust grades accordingly.

After our discussion about the additional parking, I don't feel comfortable allowing that area to be used as a staging area. I went back and reviewed the drawings, and the section thickness is not made for heavy equipment staging.... However, if we could add an inch to an inch and a half of binder, we could allow this... The current section thickness is 1.5 inches of surface and 2.5 inches of binder, I believe the binder needs to be a minimum of 3.5 inches to allow construction traffic to use this area. Please advise, we are currently prepping the area to grade, if you do want to proceed with allowing this area to be used for construction staging I need to let our men know to adjust the stone grade. If you have any questions, feel free to give me a call. Thanks




