ASSESSMENT

- The Kentucky Summative Assessment large group and accommodated testing ran from May 6th through May 13th at both Lincoln and DHS. Students in both schools worked really hard.
- State testing is a huge undertaking! Thank you to the district administration, school administrations, counselors, teachers, and support staff for all of their work to make this as seamless as possible. Testing was overall really smooth and that is a testament to everyone's hard work!
- The Alternate Kentucky Summative Assessment was also administered to students at both schools who are currently on the alternative diploma track. This is a tremendous undertaking as well and falls nearly exclusively on Ms. Buschle and Mrs. Smith.
- The ASK exam (administrative support pathway end of program exam) was administered twice in May. Seven students passed the exam during the month, taking a huge step towards being career/postsecondary ready.
- Results from the March State Junior ACT are:
 - Average Composite: 17.16
 - Average English: 16.16
 - Average Math: 17
 - Average Reading: 17.83
 - Average Science: 17.13
- The following number of students hit a benchmark on specific tests (out of 37):
 - English: 15
 - Math: 6
 - Reading: 12
 - Science: 3
 - Students who hit at least one benchmark: 17
