1. Opening Business
 - a. Approval of the Agenda

 - b. Approval of the March Minutes

 - b. Good News Report
 - i. Mr. Meyers mentioned our speaker from yesterday, Mr. Michael DeLeon and this Steered Straight Program, and how inspiring he was. Mrs. Kohrs and Mr. Ratterman completely agreed that his story was amazing and was an unbelievable benefit for our students to hear. Students were attentive to Mr. DeLeon's entire presentation, and it resonated with many of our students.

2. Student Achievement Report/Data
 - a. Post-Secondary Rate
 - i. 88% (61/69) of senior class is Post-Secondary Ready

- ii. 60% (26/43) of junior class is Post-Secondary Ready
 - iii. 20% (12/60) of sophomore class is Post-Secondary Ready
 - iv. 15% (8/54) of freshman class is Post-Secondary Ready
 - b. ACT Update
 - i. Mr. Meyers shared our average junior ACT score-we had an average composite score of 17.
 - c. Graduation Rate Update – Class of 2025
 - i. Mr. Meyer reiterated there are a handful of students who are struggling to get across the finish line to graduation. Those students have been identified and are receiving extra services.
 - d. Spring STAR Testing
 - i. As we wrap up our second week of Spring STAR Testing, we are already seeing great growth in a lot of our students in Math and Reading. We will have a more detailed Spring STAR report next month after all students have completed it.
 - e. Senior Career Fairs
 - i. Mrs. Kohrs mentioned the two career fairs seniors are attending next week in order to gain some real-world experience.
