



Key takeaways this month:

- 1. Energy usage in the month of April was consistent with 2024 with an increase of 1% in 2025.
- 2. The opening of the District Support Operations Center facilitated the elimination of three facilities in April (bus garage, Lyndale and CO south) which resulted in the removal of seven energy meters within the district. Closure of the Summit View bus facility will result in the removal of two more energy meters in May.
- 3. The IDR graph below for Simon Kenton High School demonstrates the effects of varying spring temperatures on energy usage.






Moving from Monthly Billing Data to 15-minute Interval Data
