

## Lau Plan

All districts are required to develop a local plan to meet all English Learner requirements. This plan is named from the Supreme Court case, Lau vs. Nichols 1974 and examined federally funded schools and supplementary EL programs for non-English speaking students. The Lau Plan is attached. English as a Second Language is addressed in Board Policy 08.13452.

## **Non-Traditional Instruction (NTI)**

The Non-Traditional Instruction program allows for the continuation of learning on days when the district schools are closed due to health or safety reasons. The Commissioner of Education may approve up to ten NTI days to count toward attendance days in a school calendar. For each NTI day, we receive the prior year Average Daily Attendance. The Commissioner of Education notifies school districts of any approval or denials of an NTI plan within 30 days of submission (due May 1, 2025). In the 2024-2025 School year, seven NTI days were utilized. Our NTI plan has been submitted through the approved platform and is currently being reviewed like all other districts who have submitted a plan.

## Trauma Plan

Each local board of education must develop a plan for implementing a trauma-informed approach in schools by July 1st annually. The trauma informed plan is included in the Comprehensive District Improvement Plan during Phase Four (May 1st). The Newport Independent Trauma Care team meets at the start of each school year to review and revise the plan. Increasing awareness throughout the school community, assessment of the school climate, trauma-informed discipline policies, and services to address the negative impact of trauma are key components of a trauma plan. Trauma informed care is implemented through the School Safety and Resiliency Act, specifically KRS 158.4416

## Title I

Preliminary FY 26 (2025-2026 school year) Title I, Part A allocations have been posted to use for planning purposes by the Kentucky Department of Education. The consolidated application is not open in the GMAP system. Once all allocations are received and processed by KDE, those will be uploaded to the system and the application will open. We have been notified that KDE has received no indication about the timeline for those other program allocations to be released. Newport Independents Preliminary Title I, Part A allocation is \$1,143,524.00. Title I, Part D, Subpart 2 is \$109,912.00.
