### **BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE:**

This RFP is used to establish HVAC Services contracts for the Maintenance Department to use for servicing and repairing district HVAC equipment. The RFP is evaluated on hourly rate, experience with the district and district brand equipment and having the appropriate licensed technicians to perform the work. Maintenance is recommending to award to all 5 vendors to give maintenance more options and flexibility in performing services and repairs. Cost price ranged from \$108/hour to \$125/hour. The technical score is based on meeting all of the criteria listed in the RFP and past experience working with the district. The RFP includes the option to renew the contract for additional one year periods upon Board approval up to a total of five years.
