This approval is required annually due to state regulations and Board Special Education Procedures.


SUMMARY OF MAJOR ELEMENTS:

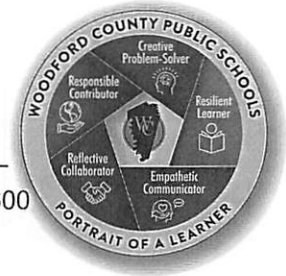
