Consent Agenda Item (Action Item): Approve MOA for services with Appalachian Regional Health Care to include four Registered Nurses to provide services within the scope of his/her training and licensure by the constraints of the KBN in the school setting for faculty, staff and any student whose parent has signed a written consent. The RN will provide services within the scope of his/her training and licensure by constraints of the KBN in the school setting for teachers, staff and any student whose parent has signed a written consent for services.

Appalachian Regional Health Care has also proposed the addition of RN's at PES, AES and BLES and FCHS to replace nursing positions non-renewed by the Floyd County Health Department. An additional Registered Nurse will be included for a total of four.

Applicable State or Regulations:

702 KAR 1:160 KRS 314.041

<u>Budget/Financial Issues:</u> No budgetary cost to the district. Student and staff insurance will be billed where applicable by Appalachian Regional Health Care. The Floyd County School System agrees to provide overall supervision by the Floyd County Schools District Health Coordinator, space for the Registered Nurses, access to a telephone, fax machine and laboratory setting. If MOA is approved there will be no cost to the district for the services provided by the Registered Nurses.

<u>Background and Rationale</u>: Student learning is impacted by physical and emotional health issues. The inclusion Registered Nurses will allow primary health care and preventive health care. The enhancement of services provided by ARH will improve the health and life of children by preventing and controlling oral disease and injuries, and improve overall health care for students, faculty and staff.

Approve MOA for the 2025-2026 School Year.
