The EHS seniors who attended Panther Academy during our first year visited on May 5 to recreate the playground photo. On May 12, kindergarten students watched the 1st grade play at Morningside. May 16 was the preschool students' last day, celebrating with a glow party. Last Thursday, our kindergarten students participated in transition field trips to Helmwood and Morningside. On Friday, the Kentucky Science Museum visited Panther Academy with an assembly and stations about electricity for the Kindergarten students. Today, the EHS Senior walk was held.

School Achievement Report/Data

- a. Student Achievement: Mrs. Kuhn reviewed the IReady student achievement results for Reading and Math from The IReady spring benchmark. In reading, 58% of the students achieved the typical growth goal and 40% of the students met the stretch growth goal. 91% of the students were on mid or above level or early on grade level in reading. In math, 68% of the students met their typical growth goal. 46% met the stretch goal. 79% of the students were on mid or above level or early on grade level in math.

School Improvement Planning

- a. Monthly Review: Reviewed the reading and math goals set in CSIP and those were met according to benchmark data. End of the year PD and next year PD will focus on curriculum document revision, improved PLC focus and revising and creating common assessments.
