Financial Report Summary

The attached financial reports for May 2025 provide a comprehensive summary of the district's financial position, including revenues, expenditures, and fund balances. As of May 31, 2025, the district's General Fund has recorded year-to-date revenues of approximately \$143.6 million against budgeted appropriations of \$159.5 million, leaving an available budget balance of \$15.9 million. Revenues are bolstered by strong local tax collections, particularly property taxes and utility tax receipts, as well as higher-than-expected interest income.

Expenditures to date total \$93 million, resulting in a positive net position of \$50.6 million when compared to budgeted figures. Notably, salary and benefit expenditures remain within anticipated ranges, and major program areas are on target or under budget. Special Revenue and Activity Funds are operating within appropriated limits, although some accounts reflect timing differences in reimbursements and transfers. Overall, the district's financial position remains strong with adequate reserves to support operations and planned initiatives.
