AGENDA ITEM (ACTION ITEM):

Consider/Approve revisions to current Certified Evaluation Plan (CEP) to reflect changes in the law resulting from House Bill 48 .

APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:

01.11 General Powers and Duties of the Board

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

Currently, the Kenton County School District has a Certified Evaluation Plan (CEP) that required all certified staff to be evaluated no less than once every three years. House Bill 48 goes into effect in July 2025 stating districts, "shall require summative evaluations [at least] once every five (5) years for a teacher or other professional who has attained continuing service status under KRS 161.740 or continuing status under KRS 156.800(7), principals, assistant principals, and other certified administrators." Additional summative evaluations may still be performed at the discretion of the immediate supervisor when needed. As required, a Certified Evaluation 50/50 Committee comprised of 50% teachers and 50% administrators met on May 23, 2025 and agreed upon the change from three years to five years in the CEP, with no other changes to the plan at this time. KDE requires Board approval for these changes.


