Grading

ACHIEVEMENT

Teachers shall maintain detailed, systematic records of the achievement of each student.

GRADE REPORTS

Grade reports shall be issued every six (6) weeks. These evaluations shall provide a record of academic progress as well as conduct.

Each primary teacher shall provide parents with a comprehensive report that is based on samples of their child's work and that includes a descriptive, narrative evaluation of all aspects of the child's progress.

A student's academic grade shall not be lowered as a disciplinary action.

The grading system for each school shall be specified in the Board approved Parent/Student and Staff Handbooks

PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES

Parent/Teacher conferences shall be scheduled biannually. Additional pParent/teacher conferences may be scheduled when requested by the parent or teacher.
