Recommendation/Motion: A motion to approve the 2025-2026 contract renewal for SAVVAS as our high quality instructional resource (HQIR) for Math) at middle and high school levels.

Background/Rationale: In spring 2024, and in accordance with KRS 160.345(2)(G), the board approved the district's current HQIR, SAVVAS *envision*, as our Tier I resource for middle and high school Math courses. This is the contract renewal for maintaining access to physical consumables and online digital licenses for 6th through 8th grades, as well as the online digital licenses for Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II for the 2025-2026 school year.

Data Considerations: By 2025, Fayette County Public Schools will increase Math proficient and distinguished in Elementary School to 69%, Middle School to 61%, High School to 62% as measured by KSA. Currently, Elementary School is 46%; Middle School is 40%; High School is 37%.
