MINUTES OF THE OWENSBORO BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

June 3, 2025 4:45 p.m.

A Public Hearing, as previously advertised, was held in the Commission Chambers at City Hall located at 101 E. 4th Street, Owensboro, Kentucky on Tuesday, June 3, 2025, at 4:45 p.m., to receive comments from the general public concerning the proposed 2025-2026 Annual Budget, the use of the Municipal Road Aid Fund and the Local Government Economic Assistance Fund as contained in the General Fund. Roll Call was taken by City Clerk Beth Davis: Mayor Tom Watson presided and Commissioners Bob Glenn, Curtis Maglinger, Jeff Sanford and Sharon NeSmith were present.

Mayor Watson recognized Finance & Support Services Director Angela Waninger who stated KRS 174.100 requires a public hearing by any local government before expending state-derived tax revenues on its roads to take the sense of the public regarding the use of these tax monies.

The approved annual budget for Fiscal Year 2025-26 contains \$1,400,000 for Municipal Road Aid and \$16,000 for Local Government Economic Assistance.

Jim Glenn, Owensboro, asked about a closed pension fund, and then retracted the question due to it not being the correct venue.

There being no further discussion or comments received, the meeting adjourned at 4:48 p.m. by motion of Mayor Watson and a second by Mayor Pro Tem Glenn.
