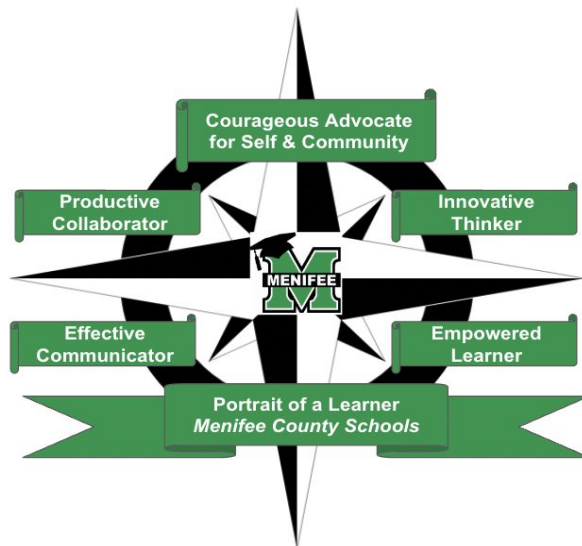

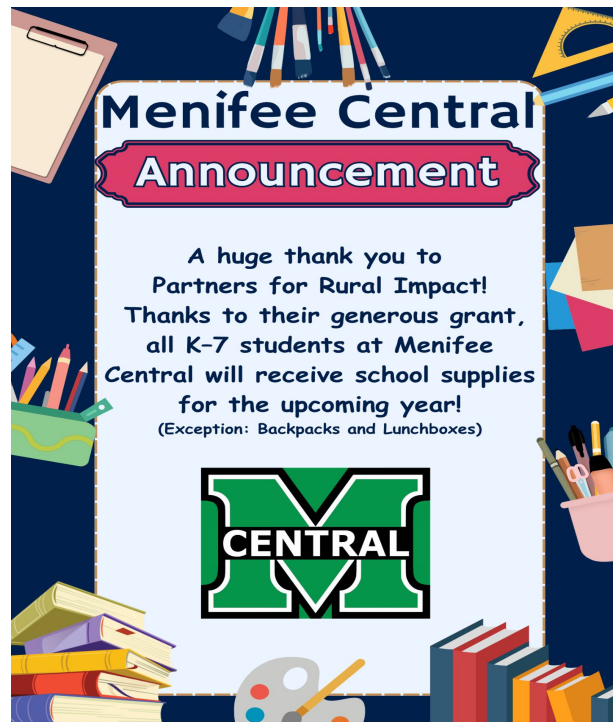
Menifee Central Instruction/Progress Monitoring
