Dropout Definition

- 1. According to the Federal definition adopted by the Kentucky Board of Education, a dropout is an individual who:
 - Was enrolled in school at some time during the previous school year (2023-2024);
 - Was not enrolled before Oct. 1 of the current school year (2024-2025);
 - Has not graduated from high school or completed a state or district approved educational program such as a GED or Alternative High School Diploma pursuant to an Individualized Education Program (IEP); and
 - Does not meet any of the following exclusionary conditions: (a) transferred to another Kentucky public school district, private school, state or district approved education program or moved out of state or country; (b) temporarily absent due to suspension; or (c) deceased.
