Dear Regulations Compiler:

The Kentucky Department of Education has reviewed administrative regulation number 704 KAR 3:455, Instructional resource adoption process in its entirety for compliance with the current law governing the subject matter of this administrative regulation.

This administrative regulation shall REMAIN IN EFFECT WITHOUT AMENDMENT because it is in compliance with current governing law. KRS 156.433 authorizes the Kentucky Board of Education (KBE) to promulgate an administrative regulation identifying instructional materials eligible for purchase, establishing a procedure for review, and developing a process for adding materials to the recommended list. KRS 156.439 further requires the KBE to promulgate an administrative regulations establishing methods for calculating and distributing a district's textbook and instructional materials allocation. 704 KAR 3:455 establishes those processes and criteria.
