Positive Developments and Highlights

There were no real issues during the regular season and the NFHS Baseball Rules Questionnaire was distributed to umpires and coaches for feedback on any issues they are seeing.

Issues of Concern (legal, playing Rules, fiscal management, etc.) With the adoption of the double first base by the NFHS Rules Committee and Board, this will be a rule beginning in 2027. It was already in the book by state adoption, but will be mandatory with the 27 season. Costs should be minimal for member schools as there are manufacturers that have this without having to have major facility changes. Discussion at the NFHS Summer Meeting was held about the future of technology (further advancement of communication from bench to players and bat technology) will continue.

Championship Update/Review Despite the challenging weather all spring sports faced, Baseball was able to get both weekends in with as minimal of schedule adjustment as possible.
