What are the federal "Title programs," and how do they benefit Hopkins County Students?		 Title I provides supports for high needs schools to support academic achievement, primarily in reading and math. Title II funds teacher and principal training and coaching so every child has an effective, well-supported educator. Title III supports students who are learning English (and their families) with language instruction and services to help them thrive. Title IV helps schools offer well-rounded learning, keep students safe and healthy, and use technology effectively.
How are Title Funds Currently Used in Hopkins County Schools?		 Title I funds are to provide additional staff for supplemental and intervention instruction, purchase supplemental educational materials & software, and support parent engagement activities and community outreach programs. Title II funds are used to provide new teacher mentoring, teacher training, and leadership development. Title III funds are used to provide resources in supporting language acquisition and family engagement for EL families. Title IV funds are used to offer supplemental materials, programs, training, and opportunities in visual and performing arts, safety, STEM, mental health, and technology.
