Emergency Management Roundtable



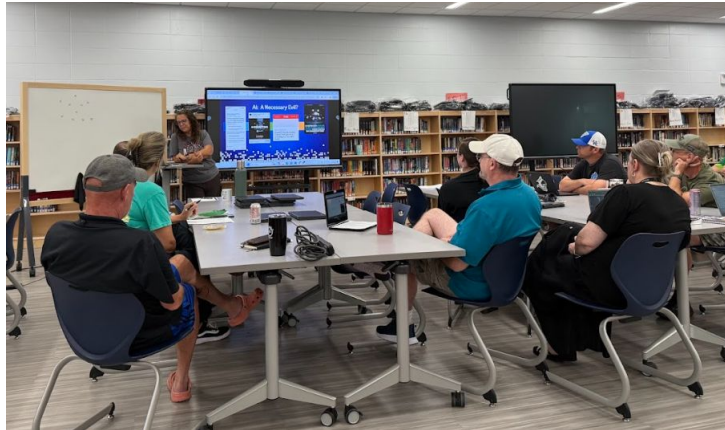
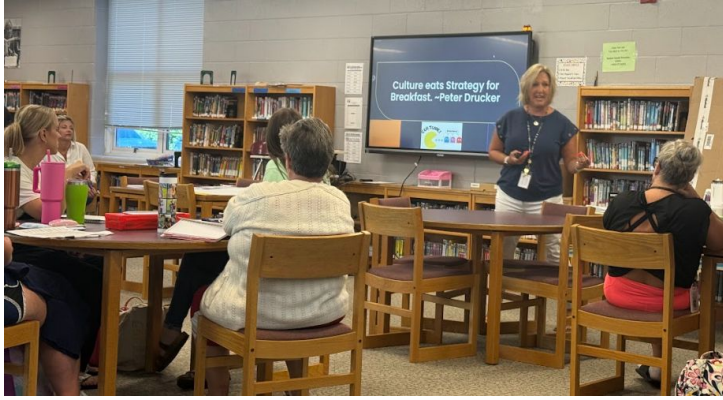
MCPS organized an Emergency Management Roundtable event with local first responders to help prepare for the upcoming school year.
