


RISD Cursive Writing

Senate Bill 167 (24 RS SB 167/GA)

Section 1. KRS 156.160 is amended to read as follows:

4. Beginning in the 2025-2026 school year, cursive writing shall be included as a course of study in all elementary schools and shall be designed to **ensure** proficiency in cursive writing by the end of grade five (5).

RISD Implementation

Grade 2 - Introduction to cursive through practicing writing full name (developmentally appropriate since print is still being mastered)

Grade 3 - Intensive approach through HQIR (Wonders) during English Language Arts classes or supplemental reading/writing blocks.

Grades 4 & 5 - Continued practice (muscle memory) through HQIR *(Wonders)* or independent writing activities as determined by teacher monitoring.

Additional Supports

Free Writing - Encourage student choice to incorporate cursive writing alongside or in place of print writing (teacher discretion)

Visual Arts - Encourage creative uses of cursive writing components into designs, calligraphy, etc.

College/Career Readiness - Include legible and fluid writing of full name in cursive as part of Russellville Ready through Senior English assessment.
