## Instruction

### Student Leadership in Action

- **Student-Led Opening Day** featured the *Student Voice Team*, providing authentic leadership opportunities and ensuring student perspectives help shape school culture, decision-making, and learning experiences.

### Staff Development & Training

- **Menifee Central** (certified & classified staff) completed *Leader in Me* 2-day training focused on building a leadership culture, empowering student voice, and fostering a shared vision for academic and personal growth.
- **MCBS** engaged in *Curriculum-Based Professional Learning* centered on syllabi development and vibrant learning, including **Defenses of Learning** and the development of high school teaching teams to design and launch **Year-Long Learning Projects** for all students aligned to CTE pathways.
- **K–3 Teachers** trained in *Magnetic Reading Tier II Intervention* to enhance targeted literacy support.
- **New Teacher Induction:** 3 days of professional learning provided both in-district and through a KVEC partnership.

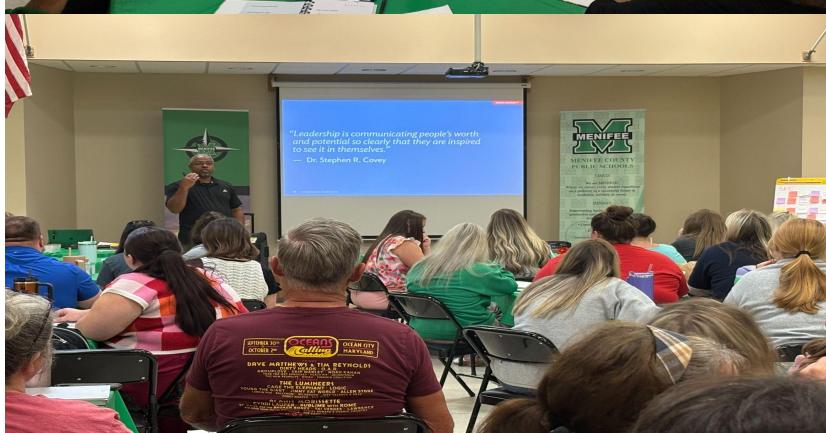
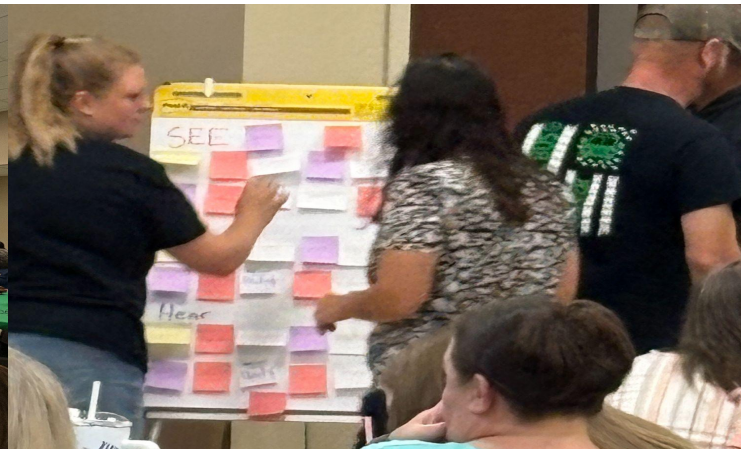

- Menifee Central faculty and staff participated in a two-day Leader in Me training at Clark Energy, focusing on leadership principles and schoolwide implementation strategies.
- Teachers also engaged in curriculum updates and professional learning on *Magnetic Reading*, our Tier II intervention resource.
- Kindergarten Camp was held on August 4th and 5th, with over 40 students in attendance.
- Our current kindergarten enrollment stands at 72 students.
