# Personally identifiable information (PII)

---

Is any data that can be used to identify a specific individual. Social Security numbers, mailing or email address, and phone numbers have most commonly been considered PII, but technology has expanded the scope of PII considerably. It can include an IP address, login IDs, social media posts, or digital images.

With so many platforms being cloud-based and containing data which constitutes PII, **data breaches become more and more common.**
