- 6 students in Ms. Buschle's class are doing work-based learning through a classroom-based business (coffee cart).
- School-To-Work
 - 3 Seniors – Total
 - Students leave campus to work.
 - Must work at least 9 hours per week.
 - Students must work 300 hours total before graduation.
 - Students become post-secondary ready upon completion of program.
 - Students check in with Ms. Fields at every pay period to report hours worked – Ms. Fields monitors program.
 - The students must obtain and maintain jobs on their own.
- We have a **total of 72 students** who will be off campus this school year.
- STAR Testing Window (August 25 – September 5th) – 1st Round
 - Test will be for grades 7-12.
 - Tests are in Reading/Math.
 - Students will be tested in their English/Math classes.
- LifeTouch student pictures will be on Tuesday, September 2nd in the morning.
 - We have a makeup scheduled date for Thursday, October 16th in the afternoon.
