The Kentucky Board of Education (KBE) held the United We Learn/Teaching and Learning Committee meeting on August 7, 2025. ## A. Read to Succeed Update

Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) Chief Academic Officer Micki Ray Marinelli and KDE Director of Early Literacy Christie Biggerstaff presented the update on the implementation of Senate Bill (SB) 9 (2022), the Read to Succeed Act. The presenters explained how, as part of this legislation, the KDE is required to establish teacher academies or coaching models focused on evidence-based reading instruction, instructional materials, and assessments for teachers of students in prekindergarten through grade 3, (KRS 158.305(10)). These efforts are supported through the Read to Succeed Fund established in KRS 158.806 and are being led by KDE's Division of Early Literacy in the Office of Teaching and Learning.
