

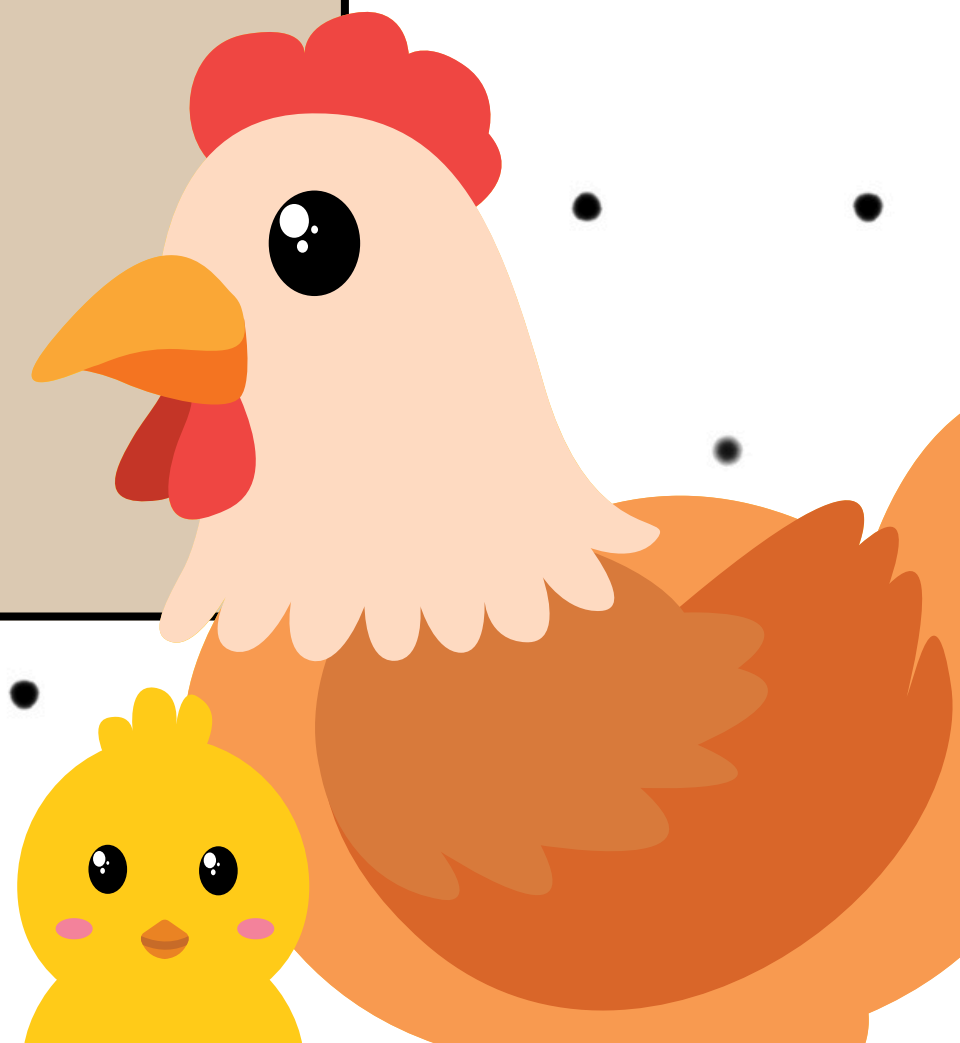
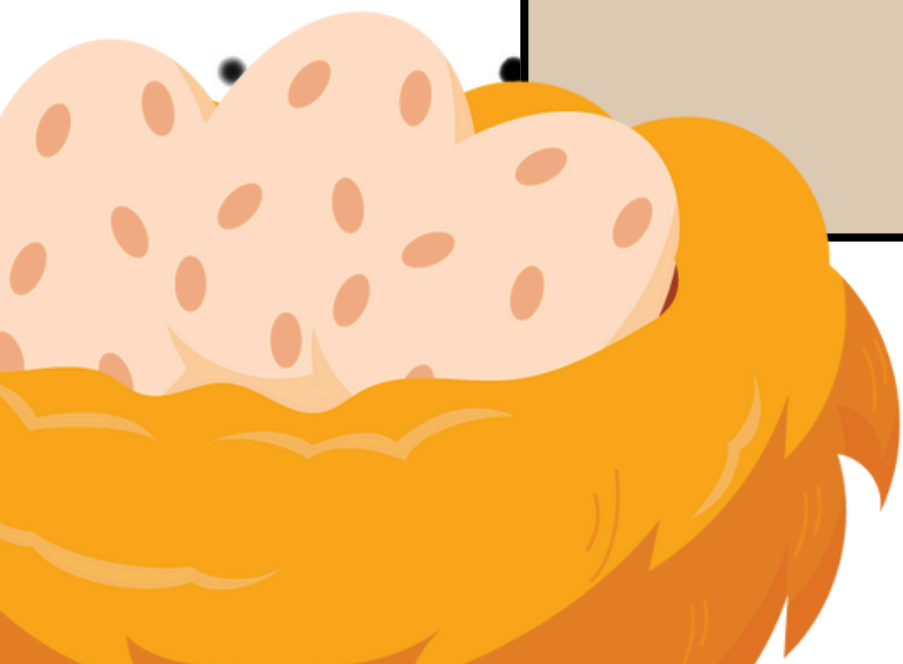

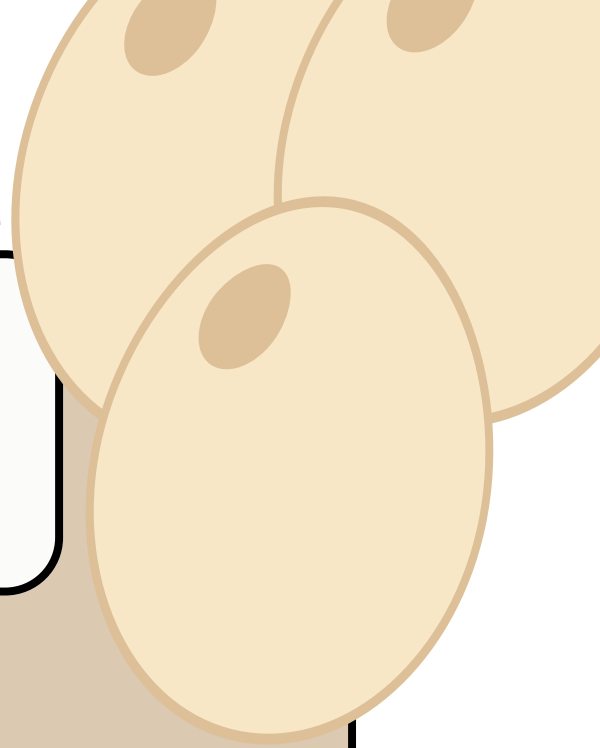

LIFE CYCLE OF A CHICKEN

Guiding Question: How can we hatch and take care of chicks to ensure survival?



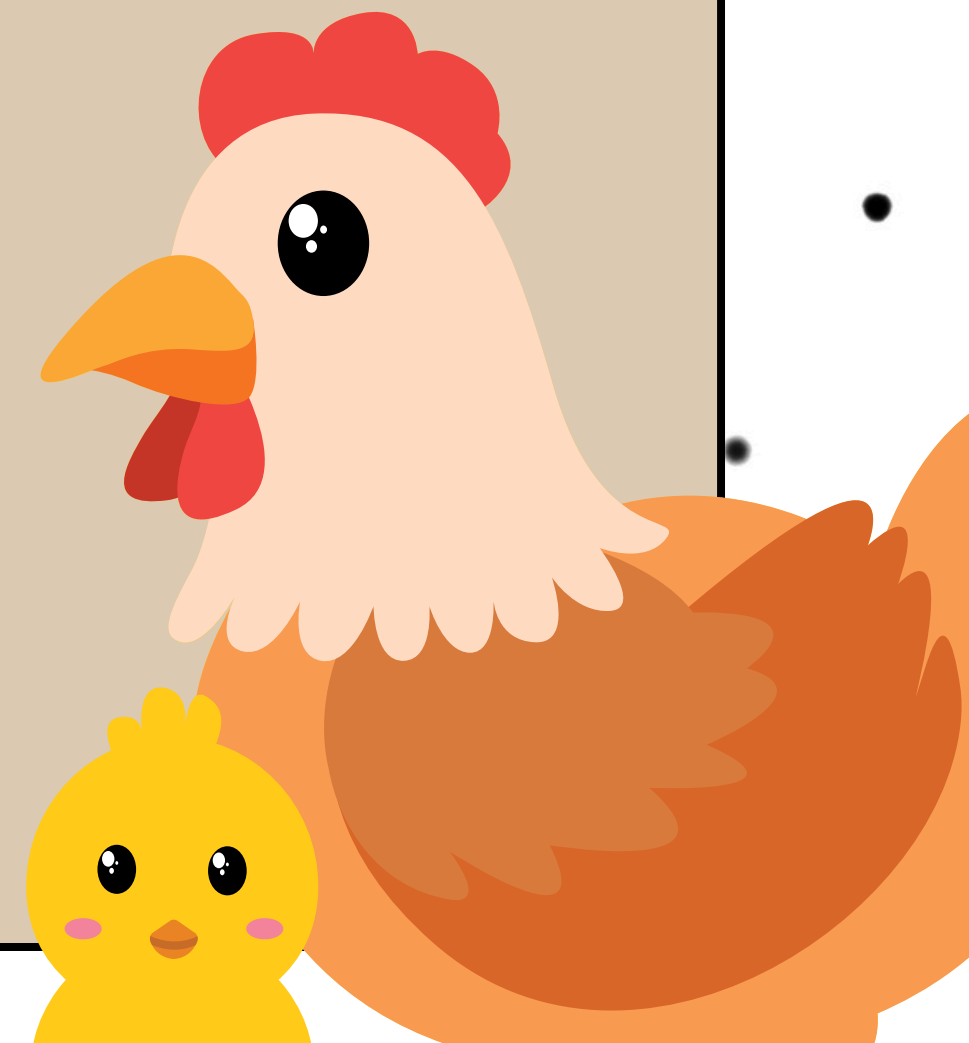
Know:

- mother keeps eggs warm
- mama lays the egg
- need food, water, shelter and air
- chick comes out wet not fluffy
- mom protects the eggs and chicks
- chicken forms from a yolk
- not a mammal (chicken doesn't give birth)
- lay more than one egg at a time
- has to be a mom
- chickens have a life cycle (like cycles of nature in knowledge)
- get more feathers as they grow
- not all eggs will turn into a chicken (some you can eat)
- grow bigger and bigger once they hatch (need food)
- need to learn how to get food

Want/Need to Know:

- Do chickens fly?
- Do we need an incubator?
- How long do the eggs need to incubate?
- What temperature does the incubator need to be on?
- What kind of food do they need?
- How long can they live?
- How do chicks go to the bathroom inside the egg?
- What makes the eggs hatch?
- Can 2 chicks grow in one egg like twins?
- How do you know what kind of egg it is?
- When does the egg hatch?
- How many chickens will hatch?
- Will all the eggs hatch?
- How do you know if it's a girl or boy chicken?
- How many chicks can hatch at the same time?
- How does a chicken stay warm?
- Do chickens have feathers in the egg?
- How long before a chick can live in the wild alone?
- Where do chickens live?
- How do you know if the chick inside the egg is alive or not?
