## **INSTRUCTION**

### **Academic Information**

Overall, it has been a great start to the school year at BMHS. We have our fall MAP data back. We are off to a solid start. We don't have true growth data to share yet as that will come in the winter and then in the spring. I am happy to share the following:

# of Students Scoring in the 50th percentile or higher for achievement

- Middle School Math - 44.8%
- Middle School Reading - 47.1%
- High School Math - 48%
- High School Reading - 63%

We will be using this data, along with teacher formative and summative assessment data to form our FOCUS groups. This is a good starting point. I look forward to seeing how our students grow come the Winter MAP assessment.

We are using a new program to either assign students to a FOCUS period for academic intervention or to allow students to pick an academic extension activity to go to during the day. We are following the priority schedule listed below. Teachers with priority each day can pull students first. Then the remainder of teachers can pull students or students can sign up. The current priority day schedule is listed below.
