# School Nutrition

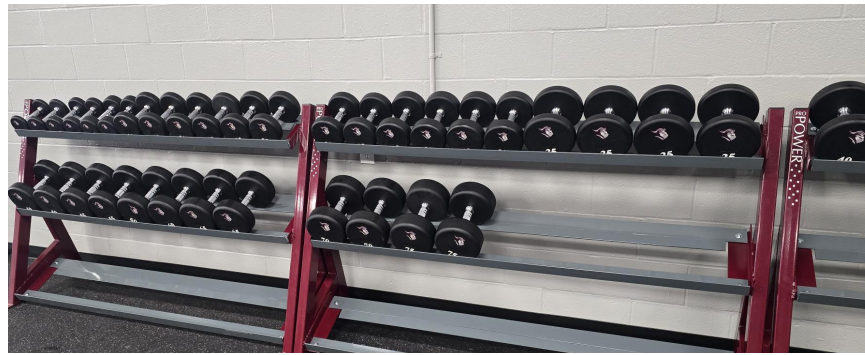

# Band

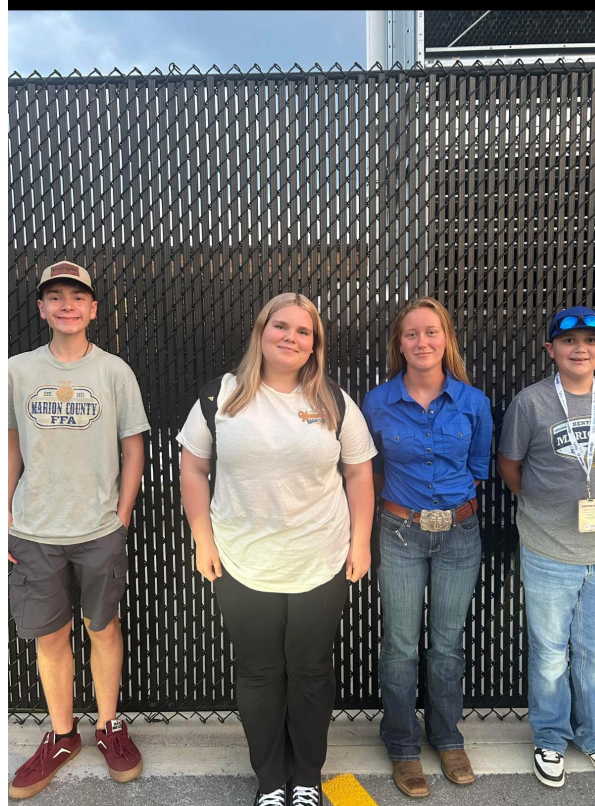


The MCHS Marching Band won 1st place in Class 2A at a competition at Washington County recently.

# LMS



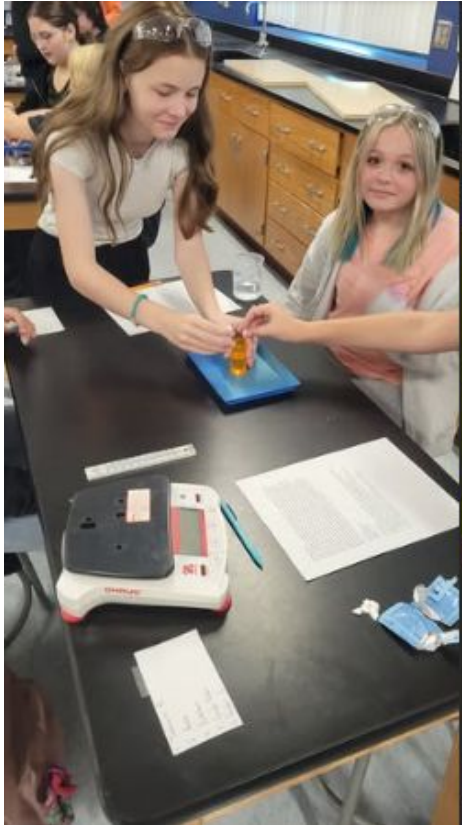
The administration at Lebanon Middle School started meeting with students for short, one-on-one “Minute Meetings” to build stronger relationships with students.
