 Menifee Central has been awarded the **Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Grant!**

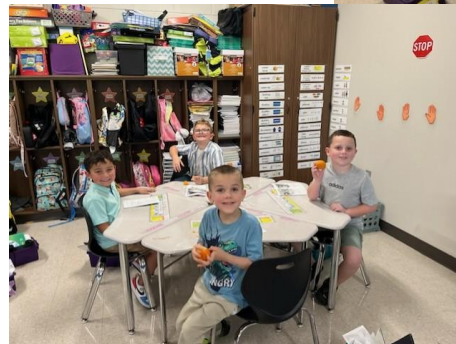

Dual Credit

We are proud to share that **77 of our students are enrolled in dual credit courses** through the University of Kentucky and Maysville Community & Technical College. That's nearly **60% of our juniors and seniors** earning both high school and college credit at the same time!

Area Technology Centers (ATC)

This year, **58 students are attending Morgan and Montgomery County ATCs**, gaining hands-on experience in career and technical fields such as Auto Technology, Auto Body, Carpentry, IT, MNA Nursing, Welding, CAD, Auto Maintenance, and HVAC.

Work-Based Learning

We also have **36 students participating in Work-Based Learning**, where they apply classroom knowledge in real-world job settings while building valuable career skills.
