District Facility Plan

Hearing Report

A Public Hearing was held at the Floyd County Board of Education Office on August 26, 2025, at 5:30 PM local time. The purpose of the hearing was to propose a District Facility Plan developed by the Floyd County Local Planning Committee (LPC). The LPC voted 13-0 in favor of the proposal and the Floyd County Board of Education voted 5-0 to approve the plan.

There were two in attendance Kevin O'Quinn, Floyd County Director of Operations and Paul Christy, KSPMA Facilitator, serving as the locally appointed Hearing officer.

COMMENTS

Paul Christy (the Hearing Officer) called the meeting to order. The Hearing Officer outlined the purpose of the hearing and the hearing procedures in accordance with 702 KAR 1:001. The Hearing Officer highlighted the proposed new District Facility Plan as follows.

There is no change to the Plan of School Organization.

All school centers will remain the same permanent facilities as currently utilized.

Priority One:

1b. New construction to replace inadequate spaces in Floyd County Area Technology Center. Major renovation of building systems more than 30 years old, not previously renovated to include: foundations, roofing, structural components, doors, windows, interior finishes, fixed equipment, sitework, structural mechanical (HVAC) and electrical. In addition, it would include construction to expand the following undersized existing pathways: construction of 1 automotive lab, 1 carpentry lab, 1 electrical lab and 1 welding lab. Additional construction of new pathway would include 1 agricultural lab, 1 engineering lab, 1 EMT lab, 1 HVAC lab, 1 ATC Health Science and 1 FSCI-health lab.

- 1c. Renovation to upgrade Prestonsburg High School, James D Adams Middle School, Allen Elementary School and South Floyd Elementary School to meet the most current Life Safety requirements of the Kentucky Building Code.
- 1d. Renovation to upgrade all facilities to meet the most current Accessibility Requirements of the Kentucky Building Code.

Priority Two:

2c. Major renovations of educational facilities: Major renovations of building systems more than 30 years old that have not been renovated in 30 years.

- Betsy Lane High School to include: windows, interior finishes, sitework and structural mechanical (HVAC). In addition to include 1 special education classroom.
- Prestonsburg High School to include: foundation, roofing, structural components, doors, windows, interior finishes, fixed equipment, sitework, structural mechanical (HVAC), electrical and plumbing.
- 3. James D Adams Middle School to include: doors, windows, interior finishes, fixed equipment, sitework, structural mechanical (HVAC) and electrical. In addition to include 1 special education classroom.
- 4. Allen Elementary School/Middle School to include: roofing, doors, windows, interior finishes, fixed equipment, sitework and structural mechanical (HVAC). In addition to including 1 science classroom, 1 band room and 1 physical education space.
- 5. Betsy Lane Elementary/Middle School to include: foundations, doors, windows, interior finishes, fixed equipment, sitework, structural mechanical (HVAC) electrical and plumbing.
- 6. Duff-Allen Elementary/Middle School to include: roofing, doors, windows, interior finishes, sitework, fixed equipment, structural mechanical (HVAC) electrical and plumbing.
- Stumbo Elementary/Middle School to include: foundations, roofing, doors, windows, interior finishes sitework, fixed equipment, structural mechanical (HVAC), electrical and plumbing.
- 8. South Floyd Elementary/Middle to include: foundations, roofing, windows, doors, interior finishes, fixed equipment, structural mechanical (HVAC) and electrical.
- May Valley Elementary/Middle School to include: roofing, doors, windows, interior finishes, fixed equipment, structural mechanical (HVAC) and electrical. In

addition to include construction of 1 science lab, 1 art classroom and 1 physical education space.

2f. Renovations of all existing facilities to meet current Accessibility Requirements of the Kentucky Building Code.

Priority Three:

- 3. Construction of non-educational additions at:
- (1) Floyd County Central Board of Education Office/Gym to include: replacement of roof.
 - (2) Prestonsburg High School to include: construction of 1 auditorium.

Priority Four:

Management support areas: Nothing required.

Priority Five:

Discretionary Construction Projects to include:

- Allen Central Track to include: replacement of existing 6 lane track, jump and throwing event area, replacement of existing perimeter fence, new asphalt and concrete plaza and new loose track equipment,
- 2. South Floyd High School Track to include: replacement of track surface.
- 3. **Prestonsburg High School** to include: the purchase of existing building to become an indoor practice facility.
- Betsy Lane High School to include: the replacement of softball field relocation, construction of new concessions, dugout, restrooms, bleachers, turf, lighting, upgrades and site modifications.
- 5. Floyd County High School to include: new infield turf and replacement of bullpens and fencing. In addition to construction of an indoor batting practice building.

The floor was opened for comments on the proposed DFP, and there were none. Additionally, there were no written comments submitted prior to the hearing. The hearing was adjourned.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

It is recommended that the District Facility Plan developed by the Floyd County Local Planning Committee and adopted by the Floyd County Board of Education be approved as the District Facilities Plan for the Floyd County School District.
