RE: Staffing and Section 6 Allocation for 2025-2026 School Year

By March 1, the board shall notify each school of tentative staffing for the next fiscal year and by May 1, the school council will receive an updated final allocation for the 2025-2026 school year. 702 KAR 3:2466(2)

Based upon projected enrollment of 204 students and staffing guidelines in Board Policy 02.4331, the total number of certified staff allocated from the general fund will be 7.

The following staff positions are not part of the 7 certified positions listed above:

Certified Staff:

- .5 Principal (Split with High School)
- 1 Guidance Counselor
- .3 Librarian/Media Specialist
- .3 Assistant Principal
- .3 Gifted and Talented Teacher
- .5 Certified Art/ CTE Teacher
- .5 Certified Music Teacher
- .5 Certified Band Teacher

Per KRS 160.345 (f) "After receiving notification of funds available to the school from the local board, the school council shall determine, within the parameters of the total available funds, the number of persons to be employed in each job classification at the school." This statute gives the school council the full authority in the area of job classification.

The 2025-2026 per pupil allocation based on the statutory minimum of \$100. The per-pupil average daily membership (ADA) allocation will be \$100.00 for the 2025-2026 school year. In the event of enrollment or ADA fluctuation, the district will make the necessary changes. The ADA August 2024-April 2025 for BCMS was 197. The amount allocated to BCMS for 2025-2026 is $(197 \times \$100 = \$19,700)$.
