Consider/Approve: a shortened school day and/or week for the 2025-2026 school year for students with medical or mental health needs that interfere with their ability to tolerate a full school day.

01.11 General Powers and Duties of the Board

**HISTORY/BACKGROUND:**

KDE allows for exceptions for KRS 158.060 (3) if a student's medical or mental health needs interfere with their ability to tolerate a full day of school, provided the school receives a physician's statement recommending a shortened school day/week, the ARC determines that the shortened school day/week is required, the IEP prescribes the length of the shortened school day/week, and the school board approves.
