

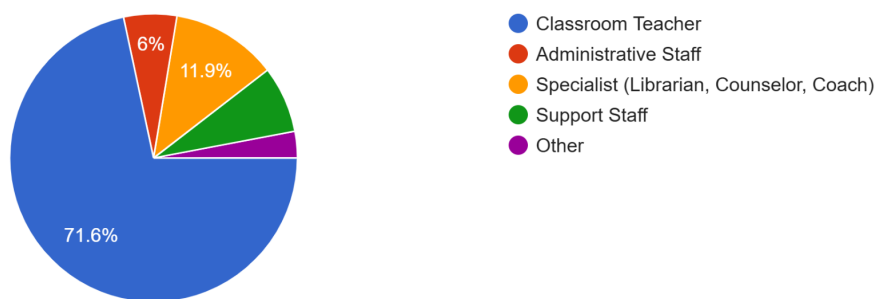

Staff met to discuss Site Based Decision Making authority as compared to the current advisory structure as each school has exited Comprehensive Support and Improvement within a two year time frame.

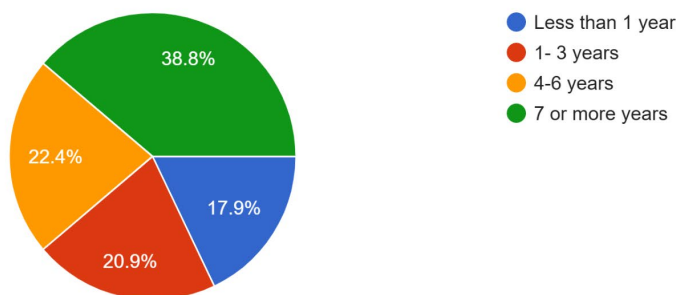
Which of the following best describes your role? (Please select one)

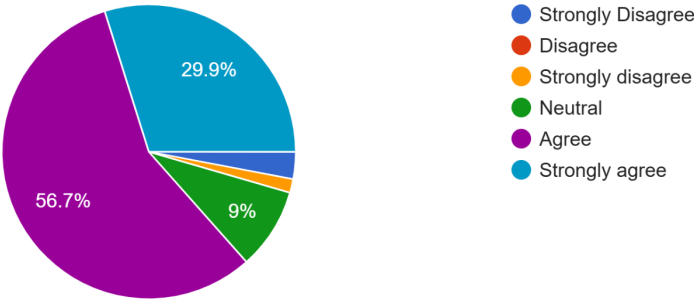
How many years have you been employed at this school?

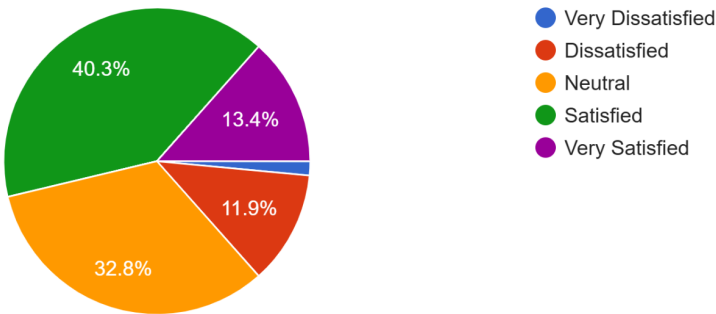
To what extent do you agree with the following statement: "Giving teachers, parents, and administrators a formal role in making key school ...ost effective way to improve student achievement".

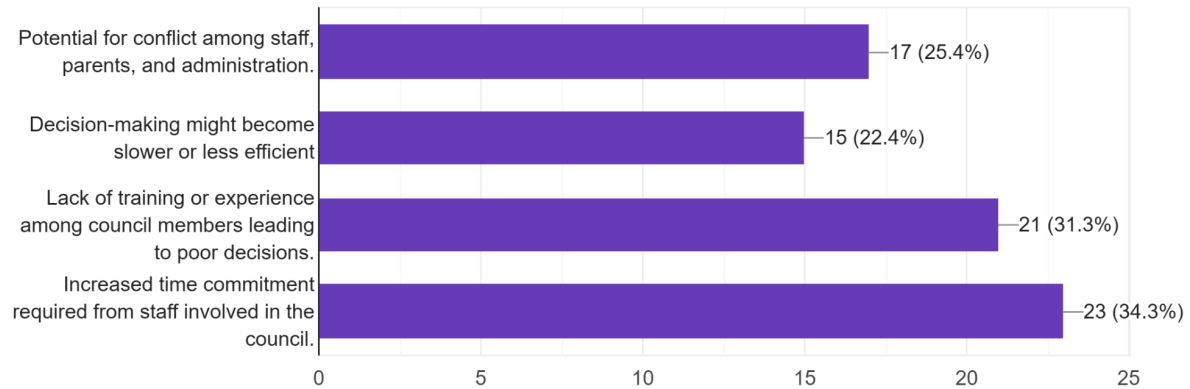
Regarding the current decision-making structure, how satisfied are you with the following? Speed and Efficiency of Decision Making:

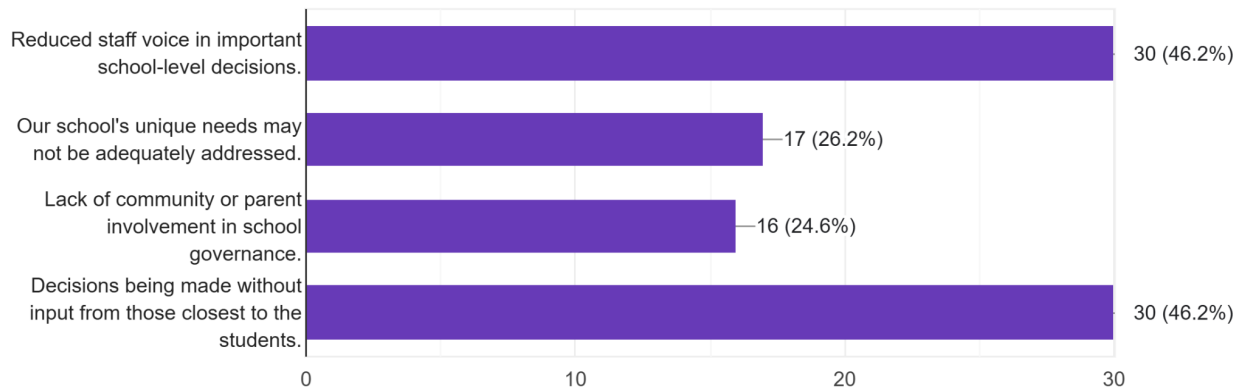
If we were to return to SBDM, which potential outcome would most concern you? (Please select one)

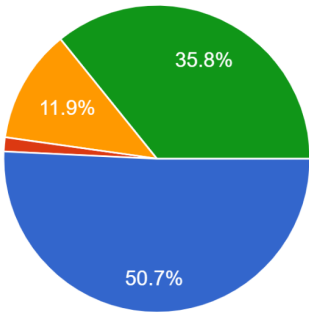
If we were to NOT return to SBDM, which potential outcome would most concern you? (Please select one)
