AGENDA ITEM (ACTION ITEM):

Consider / Approve the bid award with Radius Construction for the Piner Elementary Renovation (BG #25-353) and corresponding AIA A101 contract pending Board Attorney review.

APPLICABLE BOARD POLICY:

HISTORY/BACKGROUND:

The Board previously approved the initial BG-1 (#25-353) and schematic design for the Piner Elementary renovation project on May 5, 2025, then approved construction documents and drawings July 7, 2025. Sealed bids for this project were received and opened on September 3, 2025. Members of the Operations team evaluated the bids received from four companies using the bidder scoring matrix from section "001153 – Qualification of Bid Proposal" document included in the American Institute of Architects (AIA) bid documents provided to all bidders. After a review of bid amounts, firm experience and qualifications, business practice, and references, the Operations team selected Radius Construction as the best bid and recommended contractor to complete the project, to include accepting bid alternate 1 in addition to the base bid.

FISCAL/BUDGETARY IMPACT:

\$2,956,700 base bid and bid alternate #1

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the bid award to Radius Construction Company for the Piner Elementary Renovation (BG #25-353) and agree to enter into a AIA A101 contract with Radius Construction pending Board Attorney review.
